- Processing and retailing fisheries and aquaculture products**  
 18/11/2019  
 Greece  
 The project aims to set up transnational cooperation between FLAGs with potential for developing the FAP processing sector. This offers a valuable opportunity for fishing communities to increase the EU and worldwide market of processed FAPs while reducing overfishing. The project will focus on the following local FAPs: blue crab, mussels, sardines and anchovies.
- Fisheries and angling potential - creating the conditions for local development**

 Poland  
 A group of 9 inland and coastal FLAGs from Poland are looking for partners to involve in a cooperation project that entails the exchange of experience and joint actions, such as study visits.
- The round goby as a potential commercial opportunity in the Baltic**  
 01/10/2019  
 The round goby (*Neogobius melanostomus*) is an invasive species now common throughout the Baltic region, with economic potential. Originating in the Caspian Sea with strong markets in Ukraine and Belarus, which could be developed in Europe. This project would like to involve FLAGs that are interested in and/or with experience of catching and selling round goby from the Baltic Sea.

The FARNET Guide 20 aims to help FLAGs across the EU develop the third generation of local development strategies (LDS); more focused, more innovative, and better able to respond to local challenges. 2021 marks the start of the third period of local development support in fisheries and aquaculture areas in Europe. Thus, the vast majority of Fisheries Local Action Groups (FLAGs) can capitalise on previous experience for the development of their next LDS. The experience gained from the last two periods should allow FLAGs and MAs to identify and focus their CLLD actions on
